Read a myth or legend from Asia or the Pacific.	Draw or color a fantasy place.	 Free!	Watch a fantasy movie or show.	Write a story, poem, essay, or other piece that fits the theme.
Do something to help someone around you.	Learn about an ancient culture that left behind myths.	Watch a fairy tale adaptation.	Recreate food from a fantasy work, fairy tale, or ancient culture.	Use crafting supplies to create a fantasy creature.
Imagine your story by journaling.	Dress in clothes inspired by a fantasy character.	Use one of the library's databases (on our Research & Learn page).	Look up your family crest online or design your own.	Read a myth or legend from Europe.
