

The King Craft @ Whitehall Township Public Library 2020



Supplies needed:

Toilet Paper roll, blunt tip safety scissor, a small pompom, markers, glue or glue stick, and different colors of construction paper.

Colors of construction paper –

Orange, brown, black, or yellow for beard. You choose!

Beige, tan, brown or white for skin tone. You choose!

Yellow, gold or glitter glue for crown.

1 small brown pom pom or brown crumple paper for nose. Use any color paper for King's clothes. Use a black marker for eyes and mouth or many colors to design the king's clothes your way!

Instructions: Measure and cut construction paper to 6.5"x4" to fit TP roll for King's skin, clothes & crown. Glue on king's skin tone then his clothes to TP roll. Select the color of your choice & cut out a strip of paper for the beard. Then cut half way up that strip of paper. Use a marker to curl the king's beard & don't forget to cut off & add a piece on each side of King's face for his hair, curl all hair & glue to TP roll. Top with the crown cutting "v" shapes into 1 long edge of paper 6.5"x2" to look like a crown and glue on. Wow, What a great job! You got the king ready, yet he still needs eyes to see what he's doing & a mouth to show he's happy. Make sure to give the king a nose either with a pompom or a small crumpled paper. Follow the picture as your craft making helper! Next craft is... The Queen. Mrs. Santaliz
