

The Queen Craft @ Whitehall Township Public Library 2020



Supplies needed:

Toilet Paper roll, blunt tip safety scissor, 2 googly eyes, markers, glue or glue stick, glitter foam or glitter glue on yellow construction paper and different colors of construction paper.

Colors of construction paper –

For skin tone you can use beige, pink, tan, brown or white. Your choice!
For hair color you can use orange, brown, black, or yellow. You choose!
For her crown you can use yellow paper & add glitter glue. Use a red marker for her nose and mouth!

Instructions: Measure and cut construction paper to 6.5" x 4' to fit TP roll for Queen's skin. Glue Queen's skin tone to TP roll. Select the color of your choice & cut out a strip of paper for her hair. Then cut half way up the strip of paper. Use a marker to curl the Queen's hair, curl & glue to TP roll. Cut "V"s on 1 long edge of paper for crown & fit around TP roll 6.5"x 2". Glue crown on top of hair. Wow, What a great job! You got the Queen ready, yet she still needs eyes to see what he's doing & a mouth to show she's happy. Make sure to give the Queen a nose & mouth using a marker. Draw, cut out then glue a flower for the Queen to hold. Follow the picture as your craft making helper! Will you attend the next story time to make the King & Queen a castle to live in?
