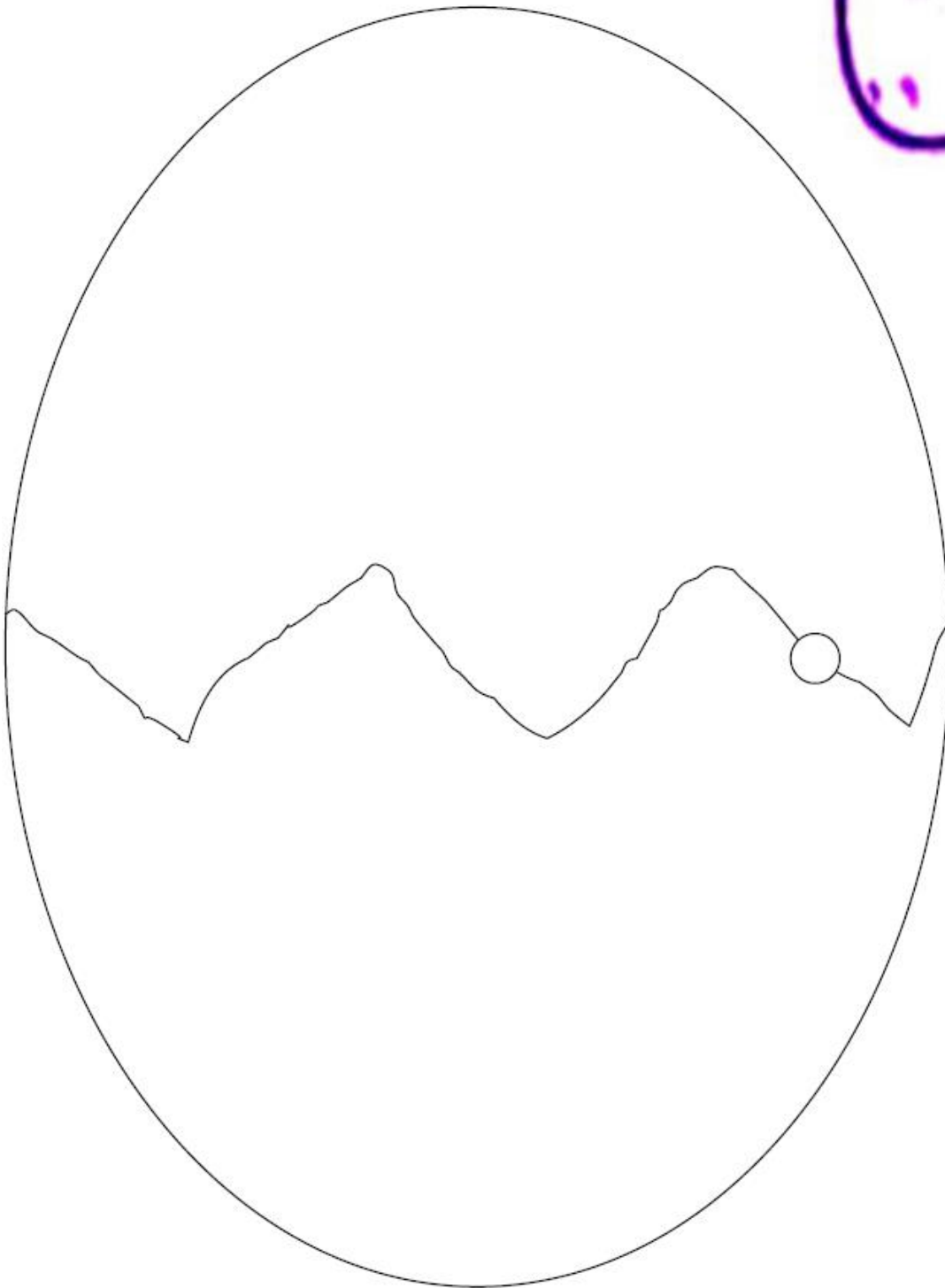

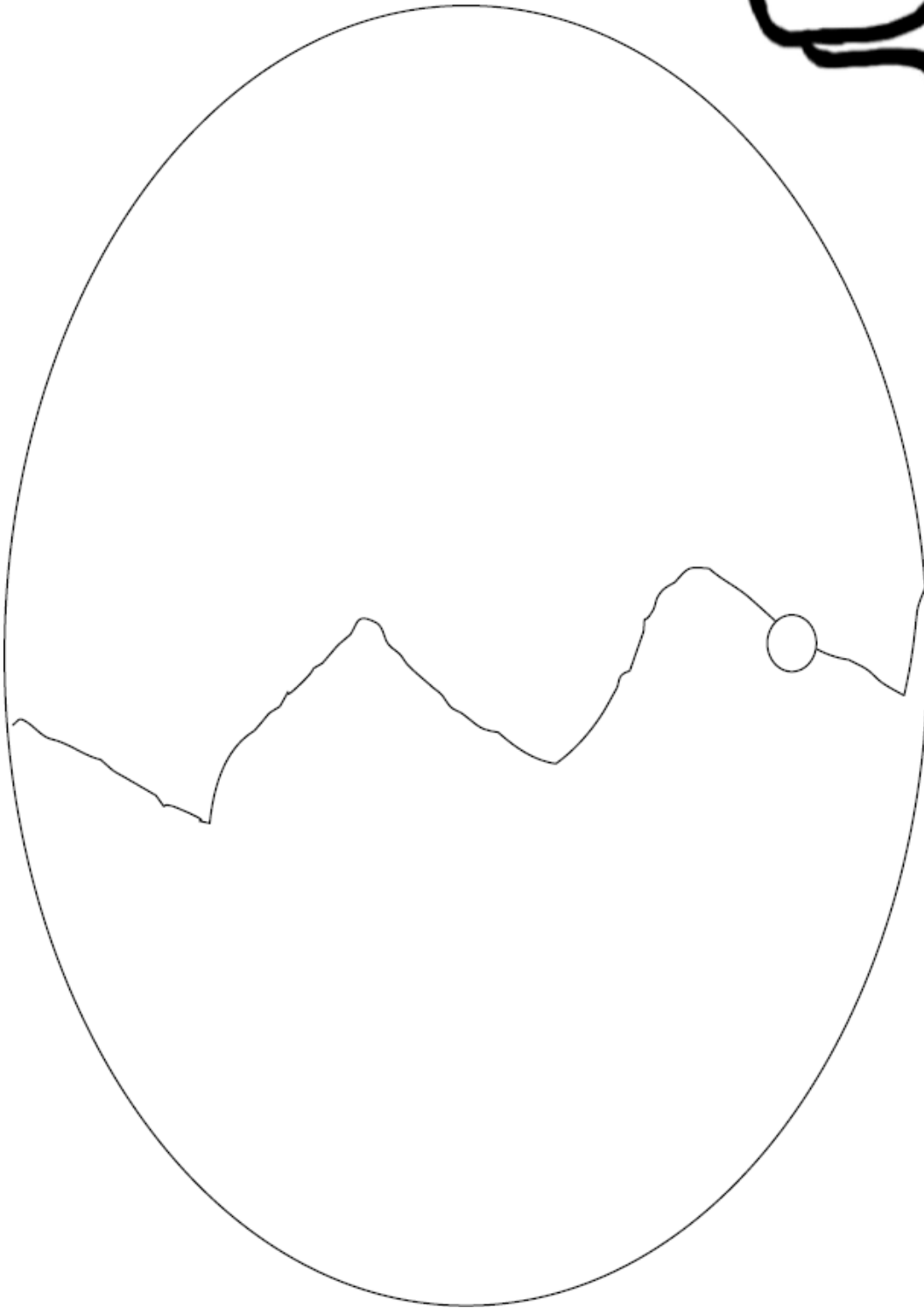

The Mesozoic Era is divided into three time periods: the Triassic (251-199.6 million years ago), the Jurassic (199.6-145.5 million years ago), and the Cretaceous (145.5-65.5 million years ago).

Instructions

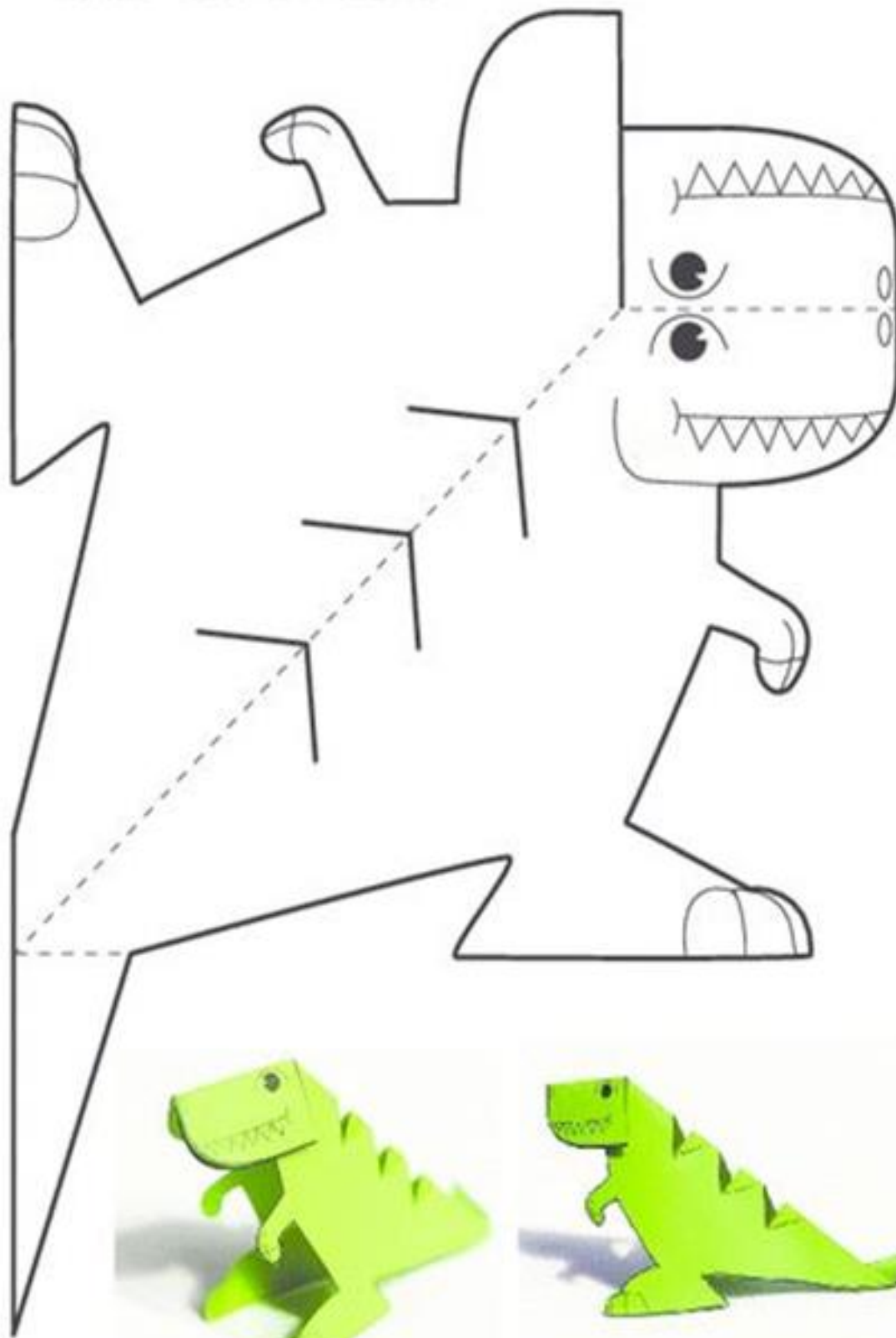
Cut out egg shape on both pages. Cut out baby dinosaur and dragonheads. Cut the crooked line on the eggs, but not all the way, just to the circle. Tape head to the bottom shell so your baby appears to be hiding behind the egg shell. When you fold over the top of the eggshells, your babies are happy to see you!

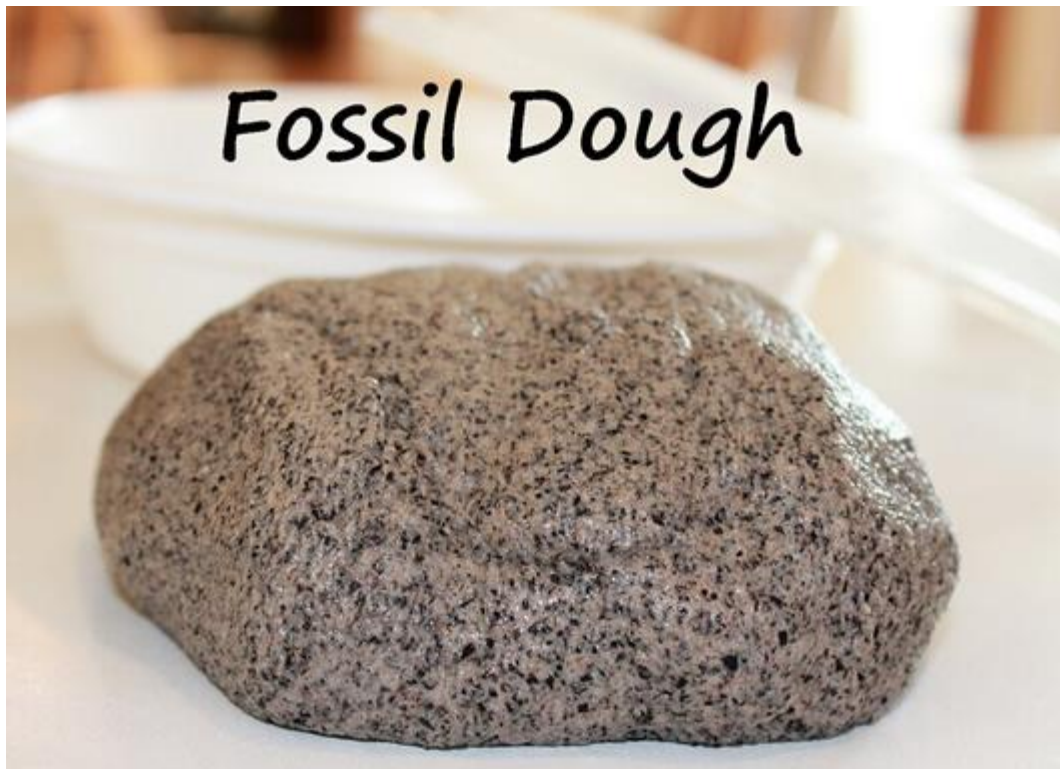
Glue-less dinosaur

Fossil Dough Recipe

1 Cup Flour

1/2 Cup Salt

1 Cup Used Coffee Grounds

1/2- 1 Cup Cold Coffee

Directions:

Mix everything together, except the coffee. Slowly add coffee until the mixture comes together. Knead the dough on a countertop. Store in an airtight container. This recipe does not air dry well.
